Safety concerns relating to family violence, bullying & online

behaviour, dogs, boy racers

Local economic development & local jobs

Reducing isolation - times of transition -

newcomers to the area & the elderly

Town centres spruced up - murals, bright planting,

maintenance & diversity of shops

we can respond to these issues.
